We're really happy to share that Deacon James Boyle will be ordained as a priest on **Saturday 28th June at 10:30am**. There'll only be two deacons getting ordained, so there's plenty of room if you'd like to come along. Everyone's very welcome! If you would like to make a gift to mark this special occasion, donation envelopes are available in the church foyer. Please place your labelled envelope in the collection plate or drop it through the presbytery letterbox. Thank you for your generosity and prayers as James prepares for this important step in his vocation.
