Sacred Heart School Summer Fair 2026

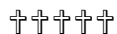

Peter's Pence

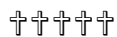
This weekend there will be a retiring collection for Peter 's Pence. This money is used to support the work of the Holy See, not only in Rome, but throughout the world.
